Narcissus Marsh's Hebrew Books from the Oxford Period at Marsh's Library in Dublin

Javier del Barco (PhD, Universidad Complutense, Madrid, 2001) is Senior Researcher at the Instituto de Lenguas y Culturas del Mediterráneo y de Oriente Próximo of the Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas (ILC-CSIC). His research focuses on questions related to the study and interpretation of the late medieval and early modern Hebrew book as a textual, historical and cultural object, including book production, usage, transmission and circulation. He has published several catalogues of Hebrew manuscripts, among which *Catálogo de manuscritos hebreos de la Comunidad de Madrid*, 3 vols. (Madrid: CSIC, 2002-2006), and *Bibliothèque Nationale de France: Hébreu 1 à 32; Manuscrits de la Bible hébraïque* (Turnhout: Brepols, 2011). He has also edited *The Late Medieval Hebrew Book in the Western Mediterranean: Manuscripts and Incunabula in Context* (Leiden/Boston: Brill, 2015).
